NEISD hosted its annual Health and Wellness Education Fair to provide free information on health-related issues to the community.



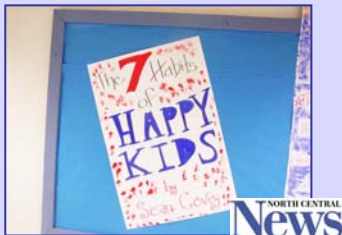
Superintendent **Dr. Richard A. Middleton** attended the public-education system based documentary "Waiting for Superman."
