Planning NEISD's future, community invited

District forms planning advisory committee

November 2, 2010 – North East ISD will form a committee to seek input from residents on the direction of NEISD's future. The district will host the first of several discussion meetings to frame this issue.

The first meeting will take place **Thursday, November 4 at 7 p.m. at the North East Community Learning Center, 8750 Tesoro Drive, Suite 217**. The meeting is open to the public.

NEISD continues to be faced with challenges such as an increasing student population, an uncertain state financial situation, and more rigorous academic standards. The committee will be asked to help NEISD explore areas of relief, which may include a future bond.

The committee will include parents, members of homeowners associations and the business community, NEISD's Citizens' Bond Advisory Committee (CBAC), Leadership North East (LNE), Districtwide Educational Improvement Council (DEIC) and administrators/teachers.

The information gathered from this process will be presented to the North East Board of Trustees in February 2011.
