**POOL OPERATOR/WATER QUALITY TECHNICIAN
FACILITY MAINTENANCE & SUPPORT DEPARTMENT**

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or General Education Degree (GED)
- One year related mechanical experience and/or water treatment experience a plus
- Certification as a Pool Operator by the State of Texas must obtain within 12 months after employment
- Class D State Certification for Potable Water Testing must be obtain within 12 months after employment
- Valid Texas Driver License with driving record that meets the requirements of the District

MAJOR PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Tests water at multiple indoor aquatic facilities and potable water systems, monitors and adjusts treatment systems to maintain optimal water chemistry (to meet or exceed standards by my the City of San Antonio Health Department) and system operation
- Manages and performs chemical water treatment of industrial water systems associated with Heating and Air Conditioning and process systems
- Forwards water treatment recommendations to controller for generating detailed preventative maintenance related work orders
- Collects samples and performs a battery of tests to include Ph, conductivity, hardness, chloride, biological, suspended solids and scale in hot and chilled water loops
- Controls the level of corrosion inhibitors used to protect cooling towers, boilers and piping systems
- Trouble shoots chemical bleed lines, conductivity controllers and chemical pumps as needed
- Adds biocides routinely as needed to combat biological growth

- Performs test to determine levels of scale and corrosion inhibitor in chilled and hot water systems on a daily basis
- Monitors water evaporation and make-up rates
- Investigates systems for leaks if trend analysis indicates excessive chemical use
- Changes loop filters on a recurring preventative maintenance schedule to insure the capture and reduction of suspended solids and sediments in loops
- Develops and maintains operational log for trend analysis and historical cost data
- Performs regular facility inspections
- Performs additional duties and accepts other responsibilities as may be assigned
