BEXAR COUNTY JROTC AIR RIFLE CLASSIC & CUP MATCH

Sponsored by the Bexar County Commissioners

MATCH PROGRAM

You are invited to compete in the Third Annual Bexar County JROTC Air Rifle Championships on **22-23-24** February 2017. Beginning at **12:30 pm** each day. Plan now to participate in this championship event. **Entry Form and Fees are due not later than 4:00 pm Wednesday, 15 February 2017. If you do not have a completed entry form and fee paid by 4:00 pm and received by the event host your team/individuals will not be entered and will not compete.**

LOCATION: Robert E. Lee High School Air Rifle Range, 1400 Jackson-Keller, San Antonio, TX 78213

DATE: Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, 22-23 & 24 February 2017, with check in and Equipment Control Checks begin one hour prior to the shooters respective relay start time.

SPONSOR: Bexar County Commissioners and Co-hosted by the JROTC Departments of John Marshall High School Navy JROTC and the North East Independent School District Army JROTC. The Bexar County Commissioners led by Commissioner Kevin Wolff, Precinct 3 and Navy veteran, has again agreed to collaborate together with representatives from across the military service sponsored JROTC programs to conduct this all JROTC Championship event for those JROTC programs that are within Bexar County or those JROTC programs that have some part of their school district in Bexar County and those districts with JROTC programs that abut Bexar County. Representatives from John Marshall High School Navy JROTC and North East Independent School District Army JROTC programs have cooperatively worked to organize and plan this annual JROTC event for the 40 plus schools eligible to compete in Air Rifle competition. This is a CMP sanctioned cup match and EIC points awarded.

EVENTS: This competition will be divided into two divisions:

- (1) Sporter Class Air Rifles, team and individuals fired concurrently in a single round of 3 X 20, 3 position shoulder-to shoulder air rifle competition.
- (2) Precision Class Rifles, team and individuals fired concurrently in a single round of 3 X 20, 3 position shoulder-to shoulder match.
- (3) Team and Individual winners in each class of competition will be determined from a review of the three days of competition and the top three scoring teams and top three scoring individuals will be identified as the event champions. There will not be a final.

TIME SCHEDULE: Range will open at **11:00** am. Equipment Check will begin one hour prior to the shooters respective relay start time. First relay of competition will begin at **12:30 pm**.

EQUIPMENT CLASSES: Competition is for Sporter and Precision class air rifles only. Equipment inspection will begin at 11:30 am each day of competition. Electronic targets and

scoring will be provided by SIUS targeting systems. CMP must manually input results into the competition tracker and award of the EIC points to deserving individuals.

COMPETITION: This is a restricted/by invitation only Air Rifle Competition for JROTC teams or individual JROTC cadets wishing to enter, complete the Entry Form and pay the Entry Fee not later than **4:00 pm** the due date of Wednesday, 15 February 2017. JROTC programs may enter as many teams or individuals in the competition as they desire until maximum range and time capacity allows. Relay **preferences and** times will be assigned based on the receipt of completed entry form and fee received by **4:00 pm** Wednesday, 15 February 2017.

RULES: The National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules will apply. All shooters must have a CMP competitor number. CMP # can be obtained at <http://www.thecmp.org/Competitions/CreateACMPNumber.pdf>

AWARDS: The top three teams will receive a team plaque and the top three individuals will receive a medal in both divisions, sporter and precision. **The Commissioners Cup** is a perpetual traveling trophy **and will be** presented to the winning team in each division of competition. Team name and team members name will be engraved on a plate and affixed to the trophy on a annual basis. The Commissioners Cup and awards will be presented to the winning teams and individuals at the next meeting of the Bexar County Commissioners Court.

ENTRY FEES: A \$50.00 per team (4 designated shooters) entry fee and a \$15.00 per individual shooter entry fee is required for participation in this JROTC restricted match. Entry Forms and Fees must be submitted in advance and the **ENTRY DEADLINE IS 4:00 pm WEDNESDAY, 15 February 2017. See attached ENTRY Form NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
