12-14 January 2017

LOCATION Three (3) sites will be used for qualification rounds of competition (1) Robert E Lee H.S. (16 Lanes), 1400 Jackson-Keller, San Antonio 78213, (2) Winston Churchill H.S. (8 Lanes), 12049 Blanco Road, San Antonio, 78216 and (3) Douglas MacArthur H.S. (8 Lanes) 2923 MacArthur View, San Antonio, 78217. Sites and electronic targets are identical in physical characteristics. **FINALS** will be conducted at the Lee campus site on Saturday, 14 January 2017.

DATE 12-13 and 14 January 2017, check in at Range Registration Desk when arriving at the Air Rifle Marksmanship Range. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, 6 January 2017**. See attached **ENTRY Form**

SPONSOR/HOST North East Independent School District (NEISD) Army JROTC Department, the Civilian Marksmanship (CMP) affiliate the North East JROTC Center Shots Shooting club and the Texas Army National Guard Recruiting and Retention Teams.

EVENTS 3 X 20, 3 Position Team and Individual match in both Sporter and Precision class of air rifle. Individual and Team events will be fired concurrently. The **Texas State All Service JROTC Air Rifle Championship is open to all Army, Marine, Navy and Air Force JROTC programs in the state of Texas**. The event will be shot and scored on SIUS electronic targets and electronic scoring system. The Governors Cup will be awarded to the first place winner of each specific branch of the military service in each class of competition.i.e. sporter class and likewise for the precision class.

TIME SCHEDULE 10:30 pm on Thursday, 12 January 2017 and 8:30 am on Friday and Saturday, 13 – 14 January 2017. The Championship **Final will begin approximately 5:00 pm** after the conclusion of the qualification relay competition on Saturday. The Final will be shot on the electronic targeting system. No spotting scopes or off hand stands are allowed on the ranges when using electronic targeting devices.

EQUIPMENT CLASSES Separate competition classes will be held for **sporter** and **precision** class rifles. Equipment control & inspection will begin one hour prior to the respective relay start time each day of competition. There are no mixed class teams in this competition. Participants must declare which class of competition they will be entering. **All entries must be verified and finalized not later than close of business on Wednesday, 11 January 2017.**

COMPETITION This is a restricted Air Rifle Competition for any Texas JROTC team or individual JROTC cadets wishing to enter and pay the Entry Fee in advance. There are no mixed class (sporter & precision) teams. Texas JROTC programs may enter as many teams in each class of competition as they desire until the maximum range and time capacity allows. Relay times will be determined on a first come first serve basis of the paid entry forms received. Relay and Lane assignments will be announced not later than Friday,6 January 2017 via email. Competition results will be electronically sent to CMP to be **manual uploaded** by CMP to the CMP tracker system. This is a sanctioned CMP match and Excellence in Competition (EIC) Points can be earned in this competition.

RULES The 2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules, 11th Edition, will apply with the following exceptions:

- 1) All shooters must have a CMP competitor number. Competitor numbers can be obtained at <http://www.thecmp.org/Competitions/CreateACMPNumber.pdf>.

- 2) Participants will not be allowed to wear clothing or use equipment that does not conform to National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules and requirements. Coaches/Instructors must review the equipment standards with your shooters in advance of reporting to the competition venue.
- 3) COACHING (Rule 5.2) or assisting a competitor during competition is not permitted while the competitor is on the firing line. While on the firing line a competitor may only communicate with a Range Officer, Safety Officer or Jury Member. See Rule 5.2.3 for exceptions to Coaching during competitions.
- 4) All JROTC Instructors must agree to and sign the participation agreement found on the accompanying Entry Form as a condition of participation in this Championship event.

PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

As a condition of Team Name team participation I Rank & Instructor Name, agree to assist in good faith and fair sportsmanship, if asked or tasked by the competition director to serve as a equipment control official, statistical official or safety official at the meet. I further agree to review with my shooters the event rules as published in the Competition Program, with noted exceptions, and the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules 2016-2018. I will cooperate with all event officials, the host and other JROTC Coaches, Instructors and facility personnel to ensure a safe, friendly and successful Air Rifle Championship event.

- 5) All participants must review, sign and turn-in the attached “Safety Briefing” at the competition. Specifically, review the Course of Fire, Time stages and safety procedures.

AWARDS 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in each competition class will receive a team award and team members will receive an appropriate medal. The top eight shooters in each class will participate in the final and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place individual winners will receive a medal. Excellence In Competition (EIC) points can be earned at this match. A “Governors Cup” will be presented to the first place (High Score) Texas team of each respective military service sponsored JROTC team in each class of competition, **sporter** or **precision**. The “Governors Cup” is a perpetual award to be rotated annually to the winning team of each service in each class of the Texas State All Service JROTC Air Rifle Championships. The winning teams name and year will be engraved and affixed to the trophy.

RANGE LOCATION and FACILITY Competition will be held at **three (3) sites for the qualification rounds of competition (1) Robert E Lee H.S. (16 Lanes), 1400 Jackson-Keller, San Antonio 78213, (2) Winston Churchill H.S. (8 Lanes), 12049 Blanco Road, San Antonio, TX 78216 and Douglas MacArthur H.S. (8 Lanes), 2923 MacArthur View, San Antonio, TX 78217. Sites are identical in physical characteristics. FINALS will be conducted at the Lee campus site on Saturday, 14 January 2017.** Each lane is equipped with a combination Monitor/Off Hand stand with a pellet pallet. No off hand stands are allowed on the range with the exception of a **left handed** shooter. Please, identify left handed shooters on the ENTRY FORM. Air Rifles will be transported on campus in opaque cases to and from the parking lots to the range facility.

ENTRY FEES Team entry fee (4 shooters) is \$100.00 and Individual (not entered on a four member team) entry fee is \$30.00 for participation in this JROTC restricted match. Entry Fees must be paid in advance and the **ENTRY DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, 6 January 2017. See attached ENTRY Forms**

Team Coach/Instructor or Chaperones are responsible for supervision of shooters after hours. There is a variety of restaurants in the immediate area to meet the taste and budgets of all participants. Snacks are also available from the onsite concession.

OTHER This competition is a shoulder-to-shoulder, 3 X 20 individual and team competition, fired concurrently, in both sporter and precision classes. The top eight shooters in each class will shoot a 10 shot standing final. The final will not count in the team scores. The SIUS electronic targets and scoring system will be used for this competition.

- Relay and lane assignments will be made on a first come first served basis of receipt of completed and paid entry forms.
- Equipment Control and Inspection will begin one hour prior to the start time of the shooters qualifying relay start time.
- Shooters must provide own pellets, air (CO2 or Compressed Air), Kneeling Rolls and Shooting Mats.
- Coaching (Rule 5.2) or assisting a competitor during competition is not permitted while the competitor is on the firing line. While on the firing line a competitor may only communicate with a Range Officer or Jury Member. See Rule 5.2.3 for exceptions to coaching during competitions
