SCHOOL DAY:

- Classes will be held Monday – Thursday beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 4:30 p.m. **There will be no Friday classes.**
- Students should not be dropped off at Olmos before 7:30 a.m. as there will not be adult supervision before that time.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided free of charge.
- Student attendance is critical; more than two absences may result in dismissal from the program.

All Bilingual Summer Programs will be held at Olmos Elementary.

BUS TRANSPORTATION:

- Free bus transportation will be provided from the home campus to the cluster summer school site and then to Olmos Elementary in the morning. In the afternoon, bus transportation will be provided from Olmos to the student’s home campus, not the bilingual cluster campus.
- The parent must provide written documentation to the Summer School campus if the child will walk home from the home campus.
- A parent or guardian **must** be at the home campus to pick up the child. Students will be returned to the summer school site if they are not picked up within ten minutes of the bus arrival time. For questions about transportation, please call: 657-8816 or 491-9980.

REGISTRATION AND TUITION/FEES:

- Contact your child’s school and speak to the Bilingual Specialist or ELL Point of Contact regarding these summer programs.
- There are no tuition or other fees (including transportation) for students attending Bilingual Summer School or Pre-Kinder/Kindergarten Summer Academy at Olmos Elementary.
- Since state and federal grants will pay for these summer programs, **NEISD may not accept students from out of district for either program at Olmos Elementary.**

CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT:

Bilingual Summer School

- 4th grade bilingual students who did not pass the reading and/or math TAKS
- Grades 1-5 bilingual students who have been retained for 2008-09

Bilingual/ESL Summer Academy

- Pre-K – K bilingual/ESL students

SUMMER INSTRUCTION:

- Bilingual Elementary Summer School 2008 is a remediation program designed for bilingual students in grades 1 - 5 who need to build their skills and knowledge base in order to be successful in the next school year.
- The Pre-K and Kindergarten Academy is an enrichment program for Bilingual and ESL Pre-K/Kinder students.
- Class size will be limited. Students will be assessed weekly; however, report cards will not be issued.
- Progress reports will be sent home on a regular basis and to the home campus at the end of Summer School.
- The home campus will be responsible for all decisions concerning promotion and retention.
