ELIGIBILITY FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

**All students must have failed the course(s)
to be enrolled in summer school**

- Any student who failed only one core course may take that one core course in the morning session only
- Any student who failed multiple core courses may take up to two core courses (language arts, math, science, or social studies)
- Any student who failed more than two core courses will not be promoted to the next grade and will need to repeat the failed grade in the 2008-09 school year

Core courses offered:

- Language Arts/Reading
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies

TUITION & FEES

All students receive free breakfast & lunch

**For students from Title I Middle Schools or for
Non-Public School students residing in NEISD who
would attend Krueger, Nimitz, or White Middle Schools**

Any of the above students do not pay tuition, fees, or costs for any courses, including transportation, but the student must complete the registration process
Midday buses to the home campus provided for students taking only one course

**For students from all other NEISD Middle Schools
Tuition will be charged for students who have failed any core courses:**

One Course = \$150 + \$5 non-refundable processing fee

Two Courses = \$300 + \$5 non-refundable processing fee

Transportation to/from home campus \$85

Midday buses to the home campus provided for students taking only one course
