Eligibility for Middle School Summer School Enrollment

All students must have failed the course(s) to be enrolled in summer school.

- Any student who failed only one core course may take that one core course during the first morning session and the free enrichment course as a second course or the parent may pick-up the student at 10:00 AM after the end of the first morning session
- Any student who failed multiple core courses may take up to two core courses (language arts, math, science, or social studies)
- Any student who failed more than two core courses and is not eligible for [Course Recovery](#) (for 8th graders only) will not be promoted to the next grade and will need to repeat the failed grade in the 2009-10 school year

**For NEISD students or for Non-Public School Students
residing in NEISD who attend/would attend
Bradley, Bush, Driscoll, Eisenhower, Harris, Jackson,
Lopez, Tejada, Wood Middle Schools**

Tuition will be charged for students who have failed any core courses:
One Course = \$150/\$75* + \$5 non-refundable processing fee
Two Courses = \$300/\$150* + \$5 non-refundable processing fee
Transportation to/from home campus = \$85/\$0*

*The student must have qualified for the Free/Reduced Priced Lunch Program during the 2008-09 school year to receive the tuition discount with free transportation. The \$5 processing fee is required for all students from these attendance zones.

**For students from Title I Middle Schools or for Non-Public School
Students residing in NEISD who would attend
Garner, Krueger, Nimitz, or White Middle Schools**

Any of the above students do not pay tuition, fees, or costs for any courses, including transportation; however, students must complete the registration process

- All summer school students receive free breakfast
 - All SSI students receive free lunch
 - Mid-morning buses to the home campus will not be provided for students taking only one course
 - Students who are taking only one course must either be picked up by a parent at Krueger at 10:00 AM or must attend the free [Reading Enrichment](#) class from 10:05 AM – 12:00 PM
 - Students residing outside of NEISD may not attend summer school
