Students currently attending North East schools are encouraged to register on-line as there is no guarantee that all courses will be open for registration on June 11, 2009. On-line registration is open from April 20 through 6:00 a.m. on June 11, 2009. NEISD cannot guarantee all classes will make. All classes, with the exception of the on-line courses, will meet four days a week, Monday—Thursday. NO Friday classes!

***Non-NEISD** students who are full-time students at non-NEISD schools are responsible for the submission of accurate information to the summer school site for course selection and enrollment during summer school. NEISD will not be responsible for enrollment in wrong courses or for errors in enrollment when the “home” campus has not furnished the summer school site accurate information at the time of registration.

NON-NEISD STUDENTS NEED TO PROVIDE THE ADDRESS FOR THEIR HOME CAMPUS AT REGISTRATION SO THAT SUMMER SCHOOL CREDIT/GRADE INFORMATION MAY BE SENT.

PROOF OF RESIDENCE IS REQUIRED FOR NON-NEISD STUDENTS. TUITION FOR NON-NEISD STUDENTS MUST BE PAID IN FULL AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.

HIGH SCHOOL COURSES

The summer school curriculum is designed to remediate students who have learning gaps, and therefore, have been unsuccessful in one or more courses. Students who are planning to graduate early or to accelerate their course of study must have their counselor's approval to enroll.

FULL-YEAR COURSES

The following full-year courses are offered for a tuition of \$250 for in-district students and \$400 for out-of-district students. If a student takes only one semester of a full-year course, the tuition is \$150 for in-district students and \$250 for out-of-district students. NEISD Free/Reduced Lunch Program students (must have qualified during the 2008-2009 school year) pay only 50% tuition, plus the \$5 processing fee, and receive free transportation. Any current NEISD student repeating English I, English ISOL, Algebra I, Biology I, Integrated Physics & Chemistry, or World Geography may take the course at the reduced cost of \$25 per semester plus the \$5 processing fee (includes free transportation). All other students pay full tuition and fees. All students, regardless of the amount for tuition and fees, **must** pay a \$5 non-refundable, one-time processing fee. **Courses listed that do not have sufficient student enrollment will not be offered.**

PAYMENT OF TUITION AND FEES

Payment for tuition and fees may be made by CASH, CHECK, MONEY ORDER OR CREDIT CARD (Visa or MasterCard) AND MUST BE PAID IN FULL AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION. Checks and money orders should be made out for the exact amount of tuition. Refunds for checks made out for more than the tuition cannot be made during registration. All tuition payments will be deposited promptly by the District. Post-dated checks will not be accepted. A \$25 fee plus tax will be charged for non-sufficient funds and other checks returned by the bank. Non-sufficient fund checks and fees not paid within 30 days will be turned over to the District Attorney's office for collection and course credit will be held until payment is made. Returned Checks may be recovered electronically along with the state allowed fee.

Please make Checks/Money Orders payable to NEISD and submit or mail to Curriculum Compliance, 8961 Tesoro Dr. Suite 419, San Antonio, Texas 78217 by June 10. If registering in person on June 11 at MacArthur High School, payment is due at the time of registration.

All Classes Meet Monday — Thursday ONLY

Students who will be enrolled for the 2nd semester only must still register by June 11, 2009. Students who register on-line for a course and pass that course in summer school are not automatically registered for another course at their home campus for the 2009-2010 school year.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Content Mastery support will be available for eligible Special Education students enrolled in regular education classes. Please notify Summer School staff of any special classroom needs.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

NEISD will offer bus transportation to MacArthur High School from the other district high schools. There will be a transportation fee for the 2009 Summer School program of \$85. Out of district students may be dropped off at an NEISD high school for bus transportation.

ATTENDANCE

NEISD summer school follows a rigorous curriculum that requires students to attend class at all times. If a student accumulates more than 3 absences, he/she will be subject to loss of credit for that course with no refund of tuition. Missing more than 30 minutes of class during any period of time constitutes an absence.

The academic intensity of the summer school program requires prompt and consistent attendance. Under the Discipline Management System of summer school, students who are persistently tardy (one to 30 minutes) to class may be dropped from attendance in summer school with no refund of tuition.

Note: 3 tardies = 1 absence

STUDENT PARKING

The school will provide parking for students in designated areas. Students who drive must register the vehicle with the school and pay a fee of \$20. This fee may be paid with cash or check. To obtain a parking permit, a student must present proof of liability insurance and a valid driver's license. Parking decals will be available at MacArthur High School in the office beginning June 17, 2009. Students do not need permits to park on campus the first two days of summer school.

DISCIPLINE MANAGEMENT

Students attending summer school sessions within NEISD are held responsible for following the Discipline Management System of NEISD. Students are expected to dress as they would during the regular school year. See the on-line Student/Parent Handbook at www.neisd.net under Regulations & Policies.

Tuition:

- In-District: \$150 for a one semester course or one semester of a full year course
- In-District: \$250 for both semesters of a full year course
- Out-of-District: \$250 for a one semester course or one semester of a full year course
- Out-of-District: \$400 for both semesters of a full year course
- NEISD student failed a designated L course in 2008-09: \$25 per semester, free transportation; must pay \$5 processing fee
- NEISD student qualified for Free/Reduced Lunch in 2008-09: 50% Reduction in tuition and free transportation; must pay \$5 processing fee

Other Fees:

\$5 Non-Refundable Processing Fee; Additional Bus Transportation Fee of \$85
