

Drama Powerpoint Presentations

1. All groups must decide on the following:

- Thematic design for the presentation
- Program design cover that can be used throughout slides
- 3-5 minute scene to perform for the class which will have a part for each member (This may be video taped but only if every member can participate and it is on a VHS cassette.)
- Introductory slide and table of contents slide
- Links to resources

2. Each individual is responsible for one of the following:

(As designed, this assignment will require each student to do outside research and to think critically about the play.)

- Information on the playwright/critics' reviews/themes of the play (in a statement)
- 5 quotations with significance/character identification/performance history
- 5 allusions with explanation/symbols (identify and give significance)
- Play analysis (must provide sources)/plot summary

3. The entire group must present the powerpoint project with each student presenting his/her slides. Please **DO NOT READ TO THE CLASS**. A powerpoint presentation should be an outline, not the entire presentation.

Do not use more than 5 lines per slide.

4. The group will present this powerpoint lesson and then dramatize the scene in a 20 minute time period. This is a strict time limit (Allow 3 minutes per member and 5 minutes for the dramatization). Rehearse the presentation and dramatization. If any member is absent, plan to perform during the next class meeting.
