Writing a Précis

Choose one of the following authors and find a literary criticism written about one of the selections we have read:

John Steinbeck
Tennessee Williams

Carl Sandburg
Arthur Miller

You may use the school library or the public library. Both of these libraries have books of literary criticism which you may find located in the 800's. You may also use the internet.

1. To access the NEISD online databases, go to your school library site.
2. Find the location for "Online Collections."
3. Use the "Gale Group." If using your computer at home, you will need to get the password from your school librarian.
(If using the public library's website, you will need your library card and member number.)
4. Locate "Literature Resource Center," and conduct a search for the author.
5. Find an article about the literature we've read. Print out the article and submit this article with your précis. You may want to print two copies, so you can make notes on your copy.
6. Write a précis of the article and be prepared to present this article for next class.
