To all persons with an interest in Tejada and Bush middle schools:

Population growth north of Loop 1604 continues to impact the District's schools. Over several voter-approved Bond packages, North East ISD has been able to purchase land and build schools in areas of residential growth. NEISD currently owns property for a middle school site north of Loop 1604, on the east side of Highway 281. A future bond issue, passed by the voters, is required to fund construction of this new middle school.

Tejada Middle School Capping: Until a new middle school can be built, the District has limited new student enrollment at Tejada Middle School. New Tejada Middle School students have been capped to Bush Middle School since the spring of 2009. This is no longer a satisfactory solution as the population at Bush has grown throughout the year. Therefore, the District is changing the capping procedure. Bush Middle School will no longer be the overflow school for new students in the Tejada attendance area. This will allow as many new Bush residents to attend the school as possible.

Anyone in the Tejada attendance area who becomes a new student after June 17, 2010 will be assigned either to Lopez Middle School or Driscoll Middle School based on his/her residential address (see table and map at end). Capped students will be provided with bus transportation to the overflow campus. Students currently capped to Bush from Tejada will not be affected by this change. Students capped out of Tejada are placed on a waiting list ordered by the date and time of their completed enrollment. Students will be offered enrollment at Tejada when space becomes available as a result of students withdrawing from Tejada. No current Tejada students will be affected by the enrollment cap.

Bush Middle School Capping: The District anticipates Bush Middle School reaching a student enrollment such that capping will be necessary. The capping procedure for Bush will become effective by grade level for any new enrolling student to the Bush attendance area after June 17, 2010 if the student population at a grade level has reached 500 students. After this date and when grade-level enrollment has reached capacity, new enrolling students in the affected grade level(s) will be overflowed to the closest campus on the west side of Highway 281, Lopez Middle School, and placed on the Bush waiting list.

Students on the waiting list will be offered enrollment at Bush (according to the waiting list order) when the population at a grade level drops below 500. Parents will have the option to remain at Lopez with District-provided transportation and their student's name will be moved down on the waiting list. Second offers to attend Bush may not occur. Students offered a seat at Bush after the end of a school year and prior to the beginning of a new school year who decline the offer will not be provided District transportation. In an effort to keep families together, if siblings have been overflowed and one is offered a seat at Bush, the other sibling(s) will receive an offer at the same time.

Elementary School: Elementary school enrollment is not affected by the Tejada and/or Bush capping at this time. However, as a new enrolling student, an elementary child(ren) is(are) subject to the cap and may be assigned to Lopez or Driscoll or another middle school upon entering the 6th grade.

Capping procedure and overflow schools will be reviewed each year and may be modified for subsequent years.
