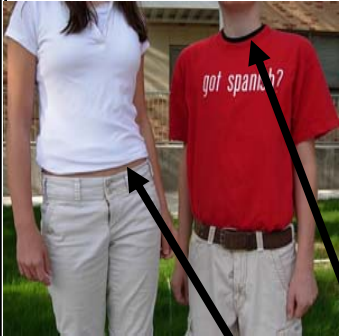




1. Shirts: **MUST** be white collared or IKE spirit shirts (Churchill & University shirts may be worn on Fridays only)



2. All undershirts (male/female) **MUST** be white only.

3. No midribs showing. **All shirts are to be tucked in** (If female shirts are too small or too tight, they will be asked to change).



4. Shorts, skorts, skirts, & dresses **MUST touch the knee.** (Yes, even this is too short)

5. No shrugs will be allowed.

6. Bottoms: Must be khaki. (No baggy/sagging pants will be allowed. Pants must be worn at waist level).



7. Sweaters, sweat shirts, sweat jackets, & hoodies: **MUST** be solid red, solid white, or **IKE ONLY** (No lettering or silk screen will be allowed on jackets). Churchill or University to be worn on Fridays only.

8. Winter coats: **MUST** be left in locker.



9. No gloves, spiked bracelets/necklaces, dog collars, or chains allowed.

10. Piercings: As stated in the NEISD Student/Parent Handbook, piercings are limited to the ears only (**NO facial or tongue piercings allowed**).

11. Shirts **MUST** be shoulder width (no under garments showing).



12. No short shorts (No frayed clothing).

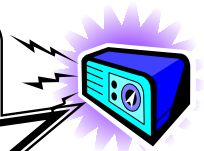
13. No holes allowed in jeans/pants/shorts.

Note: These guidelines are in addition to the student handbook and will be enforced during the 2009-2010 school year.

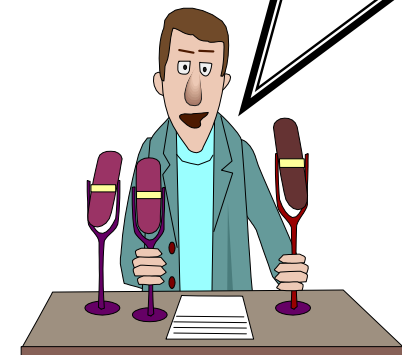
**\*\*Should a student choose to be out of uniform, they will have 2 options: call home for clothing or go to ISS for the day.**
