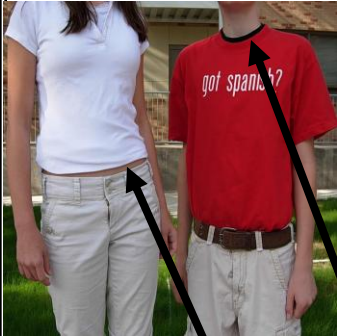




1. Shirts **MUST** be white collared or IKE spirit shirts. Churchill or University shirts may be worn on Fridays only.



2. All undershirts (male/female) **MUST** be white only.

3. **All shirts are to be tucked in.** No midriffs showing. If female shirts are too small or too tight, they will be asked to change.



4. Shorts, skorts, skirts, & dresses **MUST touch the knee.** No shrugs will be allowed.

5. Hair: No unnatural or distracting colors or highlights will be permitted. Designs may not be shaved onto head; no mohawks.

6. Bottoms must be khaki. No baggy or sagging pants will be allowed. Pants must be worn at the waist (these pants are too low). *Pant loops will be zip-tied if a student continues to sag.* Shirts must be tucked into pants.



7. Sweaters, sweat shirts, sweat jackets, & hoodies: must be **solid red, solid white,** or **IKE** only to be worn in classrooms. Other jackets/coats may be worn outside, but must be taken off in classrooms. Churchill/University sweaters or jackets may be worn on Fridays only.



8. No gloves, spiked bracelets/necklaces, dog collars, or chains allowed.

9. Piercings: Piercings are limited to the ears only. **NO facial or tongue piercings allowed.**

11. Shirts **MUST** cover shoulder. No inappropriate messages or content.



12. No torn, frayed, or patched clothing. No baggy/sagging jeans.

13. All shorts and skirts must be knee-length.



14. No athletic shorts/pants will be allowed.

15. Athletic tanks must have a shirt them.
