

Eisenhower Middle School Professional Dress Code

The purpose of the faculty dress code is to promote unity and teamwork. The North East Independent School District board policy DH (Local) addresses the issues of dress and grooming by District employees. The Policy states

The dress and grooming of District employees shall be clean, in a manner appropriate for their assignments, and in accordance with any additional standards established by their supervisors and approved by the superintendent.

All employees should subscribe to and follow a daily minimum dress code that exceeds that of students and can be best described by the phrase, “dress business casual”. The general philosophy is that we are a profession and should dress the part. In addition, it is up to each of us to set an example for our students.

Guidelines for professional dress include:

- The width of shoulder straps for shirts and/or dresses must not be less than the width of three fingers.
- Shirts that are meant to be untucked may be worn that way. However, tops must be long enough that no part of the midriff is exposed.
- Shirts with or without collars may be worn by all staff.
- Denim skirts and shirts are acceptable attire.
- Jeans of any color are not permitted. Mr. Jimenez will alert staff of permissible jean days.
- Field trips do not exempt teachers from dress code. Teachers and students are required wear appropriate attire that is in compliance with NEISD dress code.
- Capri pants that are mid-calf in length are appropriate daily attire for females.
- Ankle length pants are appropriate attire.
- Shorts of all lengths are not permitted.
- Rubber flip-flops are not allowed.
