

## SPECIAL INFORMATION

1. Students enrolling in Pre-AP classes will be required to return a commitment form signed by both the parent and the student. Pre-AP classes are available to all students willing to commit to a more rigorous and challenging course of study.
2. Students may be assigned to a class designed to reinforce **TAKS** skills in lieu of an elective or the required AIM class at any time during the school year.
3. Students not meeting the passing standard on the reading or math portion of the **TAKS** will be assigned to a reading and/or math workshop course in compliance with the state mandated Student Success Initiative.
4. **ELECTIVES:** Choose electives with care. Electives of insufficient size will not be offered. Students choosing semester electives must choose alternates, otherwise one may be chosen for you. The master schedule is built, faculty is hired, and room assignments are made based on your choices. **Once choices are made, changes cannot be permitted.**
5. **NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY:** For a student to be screened as a candidate for the National Junior Honor Society, the academic and conduct record for grade 6 and the first semester of grade 7 are used as part of the process. Students are eligible to be considered for membership the second semester of grade 7. New students will again be considered for membership the second semester of grade 8.
