analog	Representation of data using continuous signals, like a clock with a second hand that moves continuously around the face. It is measuring time.
attachment	A file sent along with an email message.
clipboard	A temporary memory area, used to transfer information within a document being edited or between documents or between programs; where the computer stores data when you use the commands "cut" or "copy".
copyright	The exclusive rights of ownership to a piece of intellectual property, such as literature, music, art, or software.
digital	Representation of data using the binary system: on and off, like a digital watch (with an LED display) where the seconds are either on or off. It is counting time.
formula	An equation that performs mathematical operations on a spreadsheet.
graphics	Pictures or images with file extensions such as .jpeg, .jpg, .bmp, .gif, and .png.
homepage	The main page out of a collection of web pages; also, the page your browser is set to use when it opens.
tab	Key which moves the cursor on the screen to a preset location in a word processing document, or to the next cell in a database or spreadsheet.
template	A pre-designed document, presentation or web page that contains little or no information, but indicates where specific information should be placed; a guide for creating a document.
