Dear Parents,

Research indicates that children who read over summer vacation maintain the reading achievements of the previous school year. Would you like to check out Huebner library books for your child to read over the summer? Here is how it works...

A parent must come to the library on **Tuesday, June 1st or Wednesday, June 2nd** between the hours of **2:30 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.**, to select the books and sign an **Agreement of Responsibility** for the books.

Up to 10 books may be checked out to each student.

Students may not check out the books on their own. A parent must sign for the books and take the books home.

Books are due back to the library during the first week of school, **August 23rd-27th, 2010**.

If you plan to move away over the summer, please do not participate. Thanks!

If it becomes necessary, please return books to the Huebner school office. The office will be open Monday through Thursday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from June 7th - June 24th. The office will be closed during the month of July. The office will re-open on August 2nd.
