Japanese I Summer Assignment (will enter Japanese I)

The purpose of this summer assignment is to practice and begin to learn **hiragana**.

- Make a set of **hiragana** flash cards. (Know hiragana? Work on katakana!)
- Find 3 web sources to learn hiragana (They can be games).
- Select a piece of music, art, or literature. Write a paragraph about it that you will share with your classmates. Be sure to include your sources of information.

Japanese II Summer Assignment (will enter Japanese II)

The purpose of this summer assignment is to expand your knowledge of **katakana**



- Make a set of **katakana** flash cards. (Know Katakana? Work on kanji!)
- Find 3 web sources to learn katakana (They can be games).
- Select a favorite Japanese sport. It can be a martial arts or other sport. Write a paragraph about it that you will share with your classmates. Be sure to include your sources of information.

Japanese III Summer Assignment (will enter Japanese III)

The purpose of this summer assignment is to expand your knowledge of **Kanji**

- Create **10 radicals for 10 Kanji** flash cards (total 100 cards). You may write or use the feature in XP to type and then paste your work on a note card.
- You may wish to work on the list of the Kanji list given by College Board.
- Write a page long essay in Japanese introducing yourself.
