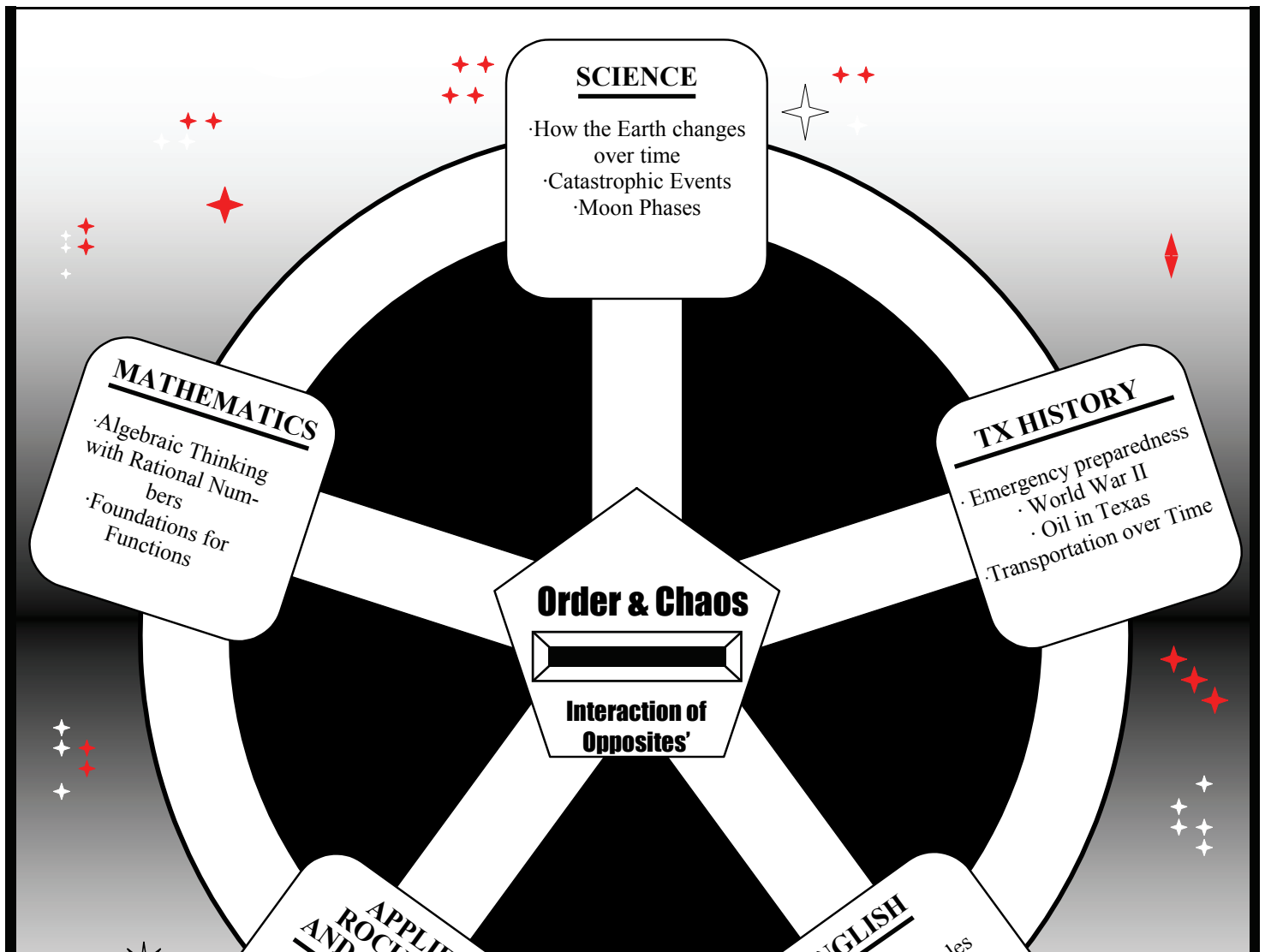
Unit Overview:
