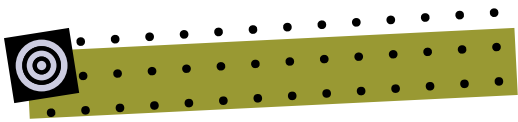

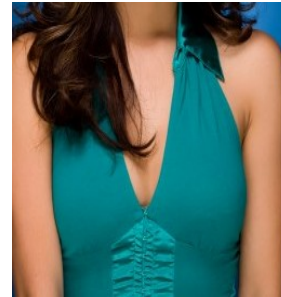


Look in the mirror and ask yourself,

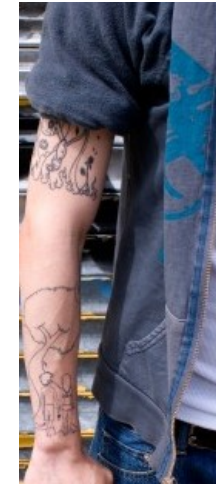
4. Be modest—**No** low-cut tops in front *or* back!! (Choose a higher neckline on your tops)
