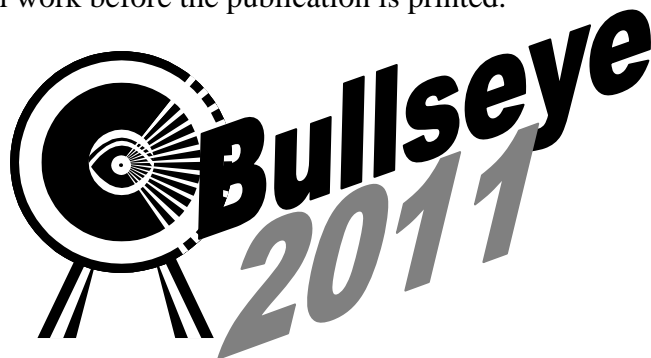

General Rules of Submission

1. Absolutely NO ANONYMOUS ENTRIES will be accepted. However, an entry may be published anonymously if so indicated on the entry form and if an adequate reason is given to the faculty advisor.
2. All writing and art entries must be the original work of a current MacArthur student and all entry forms must be signed to that effect.
3. Each student is limited to 5 art entries AND 5 writing entries. No more than 3 entries will be accepted in any one category of writing (i.e. You can enter only 3 poems and up to 2 additional pieces of writing that are not poems).
4. The only collaborative efforts (of two or more students) that will be accepted are illustrated writing pieces or photographer/sculptor pieces submitted as a single unit. Such collaborative efforts must have an entry form signed by each participant. NO PIECE OF WRITING BY MULTIPLE AUTHORS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Writing Submissions

1. Submit a typed copy. WE CANNOT RETURN YOUR WRITING ENTRIES.
2. Be sure your name is NOT on any page.
3. Number your pages
4. Mark the appropriate writing category on entry form.

Art Submissions

1. Make sure your name is on the back of the piece of art submitted.
2. Paper clip (so as not to harm the original) a separate, completed entry form to each art submission and mark the type of art.
