## JAMP - Joint Admission Medical Program

Created by the Texas Legislature in 2001, the JAMP provides guidance, training, and support to economically disadvantaged students interested in becoming physicians.

Funded through the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, JAMP is a unique partnership between all nine Texas medical schools and sixty-five public and private four-year undergraduate institutions. Since 2001, JAMP has been helping Texas students become tomorrow's medical professionals by providing:

- Support through undergraduate and graduate scholarships and summer stipends
- Mentoring and personal assistance to prepare for medical school
- Hands-on experience through summer internships
- Guaranteed admission to a Texas medical school if all requirements are met
