

Robotics CLUB GUIDELINES

The Robotics Club is made up of fourth and fifth graders who want to participate in extra curricular activities. Students attending the weekly Robotics Club meetings are expected to follow the NEISD Code of Conduct.

Here are a few reminders for the clubs:

- Please be punctual. Tardiness will be noted as an unexcused absence.
- Three unexcused absences will be means for dismissal.
- Should you be absent, please bring a note from your parent to the next club meeting so that the absence may be excused.
- Enter the room where the club is to be held in a quiet and orderly manner.
- Three late pick-ups will be means for dismissal.
- Always give your best effort and attention.
- Remember that no gum or food is allowed.
- Maintain passing grades in all classes **(required)**.
- Maintain at least an “S” in conduct and be a self-manager **(required)**.
- Maintain appropriate behavior at any after school function.

Regarding Late Pickups:

Please do your best to be here on time, if not a few minutes before. Students will **not** be marked as a late pickup as long as their ride is there **before the main traffic stream is gone**. However, should your child have to wait, it will be noted as a “late pickup.” **Three (3) late pickups** are means for **dismissal**. This is both for the sake of your child (They get very upset if they are the last ones there!) and due to our own personal family and time constraints.

In addition, if there is **one excessively late pickup (20 minutes or more)** this will be grounds for **immediate dismissal from the club**.

Should you encounter **an emergency situation**, please call and let us know as soon as possible.

Academic Probation:

All club members are required to maintain both conduct and academic grades. However, if a student has not maintained at least an “S” in conduct, have their self-manager badge, and a passing grade in all subjects, they will be on academic probation.

(Probation = not allowed to participate in any club activity for the following 9 weeks.)

Should a student be on probation, they will have the **next 9 weeks to improve their conduct/academic grades**. They will be able to rejoin after their next report card is issued.

If they **do not improve their conduct/grades**, they will **no longer be able to participate** in the club.

Remember, academics must be a priority!
