Not a New Program; A New Era!

What are Extended School Year (ESY) Services?

- Individual, tailored plans
- Determined by ARD
- Based on data
- Necessary for FAPE
- Based on regression & recoupment time

ESY is not...

- Limited to a particular disability
- Unilateral services
- Childcare
- A chance to work on new skills
- Continuation of IEP program
- Required every day, all day
- Automatically provided

Who can receive ESY?

Special Education students needing support maintaining critical skills learned during the school year.

What are ESY Services?

ESY services vary in intensity, location, type and length of time, depending on each student's needs.

How is the ESY decision made?

ESY eligibility decisions are made in an ARD meeting based on the following:

- Progress toward IEP goals
- Nature and severity of disability
- Likelihood (during school break) of regression in critical skill areas, and;
- Lengthy recoupment period to regain skills.

When is the ESY decision

made? The determination for ESY is usually made during the student's annual ARD meeting. Additionally, you may request an ARD meeting to determine ESY eligibility at any time.

What if I don't agree with the ESY eligibility determination?

If you disagree with an ARD determination, you may resolve the disagreement by following due process procedures outlined in your Parent's Handbook.
