- Capabilities to store content and burn CD

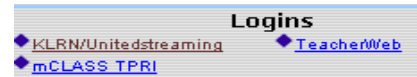

- **Find the Streaming Video content- Use Internet Explorer**

Access from NEISD homepage > Quick Links or
NEISD homepage > Intranet > Logins



Locate appropriate content using search terms or Curriculum Standards Search

- **Download Clips** -- rather than entire videos. Select "Video Segments" tab.

- **Step 1: Right click** on the download icon  in front of the clip. Select "**Save Target As**"

- **Step 2: Select the location** to save the file. **(Do not save to the Network (Staff/Student Shared))** "My Documents" or the Desktop. Create a new folder by clicking on the "**new folder**" icon. Rename the folder. Double click on the folder so it appears in the box next to **Save As**. The PowerPoint presentation **must** be saved in the same folder.

- **Step 3: Rename** the file and click "Save"
Click "**Close this dialog box when download completes**"
You can save clips from a variety of videos into the same folder.

Clips can also be burned to and accessed from CD. (see directions below)






• Create PowerPoint

It is easiest to embed video clips into their own blank slide.

Ultimately you **MUST** save the presentation in the same folder as the clips.

Embedding *unitedstreaming* Video Into PowerPoint™

<p>1. To insert a video, go to Insert> Movies and Sounds> Movie from File</p> <p><i>No text is needed to insert the video.</i></p>	
<p>2. Navigate and select the video.</p> <p>3. Click OK.</p>	
<p>4. Decide whether you wish to have the video play automatically or not.</p> <p>5. To resize your video:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Click once on the video. ▪ Click on one of the four corner boxes on the video still. ▪ Click and stretch diagonally – this will keep your video proportionate. <p>6. To test your video, go to "Slide Show" > "View Show." Hover your mouse over the link and notice it turns to a hand. (Left) Click to play the video.</p>	

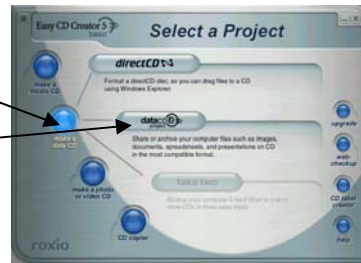
Select "Yes" to have video play automatically during slide show

Save presentation into the same folder as the video clips

• Burn presentation to CD

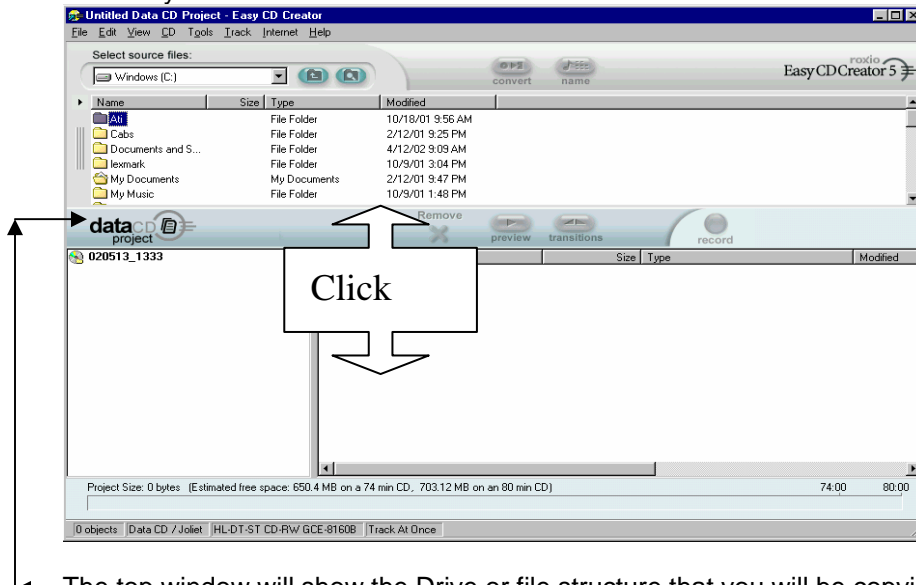
1. Double click the Easy CD Creator button on your desktop or Start > Programs > Roxio Easy CD Creator 5 > Project Selector
2. A blue window will open up and you will need to put your cursor on the “Make Data CD” button.

Click on the Data CD button



3. Select Data CD.

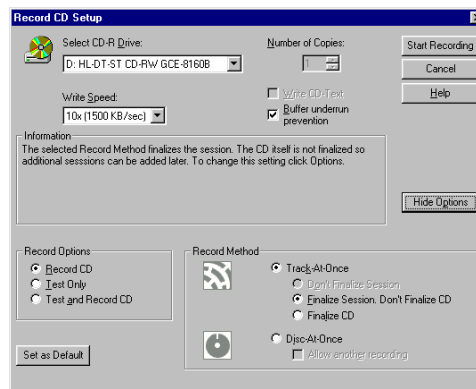
Another window will open and this will be the window from which you choose the files that you wish to burn or archive onto you CD.



4. Click and hold on the file that you want to copy and drag from the Top window into the lower right window. The files will be copied into the lower right window.

*The lower left window shows the numbered name of your blank CD. You can rename the CD as you would any file so that you will know what is in the CD drive. The “Record” button will turn “Red” when you drop files to be copied.

5. Click on Record. The following window will pop up. Leave the default settings.



These are default settings.
Leave them alone.

6. Click Start Recording.
