About Your Board

North East ISD is governed by a seven-member school board elected by its residents. Each trustee represents a single member district in which they reside and serves a four-year term.

Meetings

To conduct business in an open format, board meetings are regularly scheduled on the second Monday of each month at the North East Education Center (NEEC), 8961 Tesoro Drive. At all regularly scheduled meetings, the executive session begins at 5:30 p.m., and the open meeting portion convenes at 6:30 p.m.

Within the limits of the Texas Open Meetings Law, parts of the Board meeting may be closed to the public (executive session) so the Board may consider real estate transactions, personnel matters, student hearings and other legal matters. All actions on items considered during executive sessions must be acted upon during the open portion of the meeting. A majority of the Board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.

Special board meetings are called as needed. Notice of all board meetings is posted 72 hours in advance on a bulletin board located at the front entrance of the NEEC. The



Addressing the Board

Matters From the Floor is time provided during regular board meetings for citizens to address the Board on any issues or concerns they may have.

Topics may not include the character of any student, staff or Board member.

Each person who signs up to speak just prior to the meeting can address the Board one time for no more than five minutes.

Due to time constraints, a presentation involving more than one person is not permitted.

Speakers will be asked to provide both their name and their street address before addressing the topic.

Following the citizen's presentation, board members cannot respond to issues or concerns that were not listed on the agenda, but they may assign an issue to a future agenda or to the administration for further study.

If a speaker has signed up to cover a topic already included in the agenda, the Board will call the speaker forward during that agenda time. Since the topic will already be addressed for the speaker, time is limited to three minutes.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

Each citizen is given five minutes, and the Board cannot respond to issues or concerns not published on the agenda.
