

INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

PRIVATE MUSIC  
LESSONS

The district recognizes that in order to maintain a quality program in vocal/instrumental music programs, it is important that the music student enrolled in band, choir, and orchestra classes have access to private instruction. In order to make such instruction conveniently available to students across the district, the use of campus facilities before and after school and during the lunch hour shall be authorized. In accordance with TEA directives, the following guidelines shall apply:

1. All private instruction shall be conducted at the direction of the music director on the campus with the approval of the principal.
2. No private instruction shall take place on a campus without a certified staff member (usually the music director whose students are receiving the instruction) being present. At no time shall a private instructor be allowed to use our campus facilities without a certified staff member being present.
3. The district shall maintain a list of approved instructors that shall be allowed to teach on campus.
4. Each private instructor shall pay an annual fee of \$10.00 to the district to help defray utilities cost. This payment shall be paid to the fine arts director prior to the instructor's name appearing on the Approved List of Instructors.
5. The fee for a 1/2 hour private lesson shall not exceed \$10.00.
6. The district shall not be responsible for paying the instructor or for collecting the lesson fees. These fees shall be paid directly to the instructor by the student.
7. A yearly review of this program shall be conducted by the fine arts director to ascertain the relative effectiveness of such a program.
