SUMMER SCHOOL

OUT-OF-DISTRICT
SUMMER PROGRAMS

Any student to be awarded high school credit for graduation through out-of-district summer courses must have pre-approval. Summer enrichment activities shall be encouraged. In order for credit to be recorded on the student's Academic Achievement Record (AAR), the course shall meet all state requirements and shall have been pre-approved, as required for any regular summer school course.

CREDIT

The request for pre-approval of special summer programs for credit shall be directed to the campus administrator or counselor. The request for credit shall be submitted to the appropriate district curriculum program coordinator who shall evaluate the course content and time requirements to ascertain that State requirements are met. Course validation testing may be required upon course completion. The Special Credit Options committee shall review pre-approval requests, as needed. Final authority for pre-approval shall lie with the Department of Curriculum and Instructional Support.
