SUBJECT: Thanksgiving Rifle Match

1. You are invited to participate in the Twenty-second Annual Thanksgiving Air Rifle Match on Saturday, 11 November 2006. The match will be fired on the Theodore Roosevelt range, 5110 Walzem Road, San Antonio, TX 78218.
2. The match will be governed by 2005 NRA Position Air Rifle Rules with some exceptions (see enclosure 1). The course will consist of 10 shots each in the prone, standing, and kneeling positions. Cadets who are formally enrolled in JROTC and are eligible to compete IAW TEA eligibility rules for extracurricular activities may participate as team members. Only teams may enter the match. This Rifle Range has eight firing lanes; therefore, schools may enter two (2) teams. Teams may have a maximum of four (4) shooters. All four shooter's scores will count.
3. Request the registration form with entry fee be returned NLT 3 November 2006. Teams will be notified of firing times by 6 November. Local teams may fire in the afternoon hours during the week of 11 November 2006. Out of town teams will fire on the Saturday of the meet. MATCH INFORMATION

DATE: 11 November 2006

LOCATION: Theodore Roosevelt High School, 5110 Walzem Road, San Antonio, TX 78218

TEAMS: Four (4) persons team consisting of JROTC cadets eligible to compete in accordance with Texas Education Agency rules. Schools may enter only one team. No individual entries.

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00 per team

COURSE: Ten (10) record shots in each of three positions (prone, standing, kneeling) in that order. NRA targets AR 5/10 will be used.

AWARDS: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place team trophies.
1st, 2nd, 3rd place team awards for each position.
1st, 2nd, 3rd place individual overall scores.
Turkey for individuals firing maximum score (100) from any position.

RULES: The match will be governed by 2005 NRA POSITION AIR RIFLE RULES except as noted below:

- a. Rule 1.1. The match will be NRA non-sanctional shoulder -to-shoulder.
- b. Rule 3.11.1 (a). The shooting jackets may be closed with the use of draw ties and/or buttons/snaps, and may exceed the specification for overlap.
- c. Rule 3.11.1 (c). Any shoe/boot is acceptable.
- d. Rule 3.13. Slings cannot be used in standing position.
- e. Rule 8.2. Firers will have 50 minutes to fire the match. The 50 minutes include sighting shots and transition from one position to another
- f. Please NOTE: Palm rests and butt hooks are prohibited.

EQUIPMENT: Teams must provide all equipment for firing, except pellets and targets.
