

Middle School Dyslexia Services

Transition of 5th grade students to 6th grade

- The Dyslexia or 504 Committee meets in Spring of 5th grade year to review student's progress and determine level of dyslexia service for 6th grade.

Transfer of information

- Dyslexia folders are to be delivered to receiving middle school campus prior to May 24th.

Dyslexia Services in Middle School

- Dyslexia contact should be an SSI teacher who will work with dyslexia students still needing direct instruction.
- Form letter sent home within the first ten days of school indicating level of support student will receive.
- One or more SSI teachers per middle school campus

The SSI Dyslexia contact(s) at middle school:

- Must attend a dyslexia meeting before or within the first three weeks of the start of school
- Training provided on serving students with dyslexia
- Receive training in Megawords

Dyslexia Intervention

- For students needing direct instruction, the Rex Extreme program used for SSI is supplemented with Megawords to ensure that essential components of reading instruction are addressed.
