

DRESS FOR SUCCESS

Standard dress is required for all students enrolled at Garner Middle School and must be worn daily. The student's uniform must fit properly. A student not in uniform will be sent to the front office to address the matter. From the moment students arrive on campus in the morning until they are completely off campus in the afternoon, students must be in uniform. Parents are expected to provide attire that complies with the school and district's dress policy.

- Any clothing deemed inappropriate by an administrator because it is a distraction to learning will not be permitted.

Non-Compliance of Standard Dress Policy

If a student arrives at school and is not in compliance with the school's standard dress policy, the following will occur:

- The student will call home for a change of clothing. If no one is available to bring clothes to school, the student will be given a change of clothes or may be placed in In-School Suspension if they do not comply.
- Persistent non-compliance with the standard dress policy will be considered insubordination and dealt with accordingly by an administrator.

During any free dress day, NEISD Dress code must be followed. The Student/Parent Handbook has detailed information on the NEISD Dress Code.

BOYS' STANDARD DRESS POLICY

Solid navy or khaki pants or shorts. Pants and shorts must be hemmed. Sweatpants and Pajama Pants are prohibited.

Solid navy, white, or royal blue shirt with collar. Shirts must have buttons and sleeves.

Visible undershirts must be white only.

Spirit shirts from Garner or MacArthur may be worn any day of the week. Spirit shirts from other campuses are not allowed. Jeans are only allowed on Fridays with a college shirt.

Students may wear jeans (blue or black) on Friday with a college shirt. The college shirt must represent an accredited college. Jeans may not sag, have holes, shreds or are torn and must be hemmed.

Oversized clothing is not permitted.

Because we are a uniform campus with a uniform dress policy, hair color is part of that expectation. No unnatural hair colors will be allowed.

GIRLS' STANDARD DRESS POLICY

Solid navy or khaki pants, shorts, skirt, or dress/jumper. Sweatpants and Pajama Pants are prohibited. Pants and shorts must be hemmed.

Solid navy, white, or royal blue shirt or blouse with collar.

Visible undershirts must be white only. Undergarments must not be visible.

Spirit shirts from Garner or MacArthur may be worn any day of the week. Spirit shirts from other campuses are not allowed. Jeans are only allowed on Fridays with a college shirt.

Students may wear jeans (blue or black) on Friday with a college shirt. The college shirt must represent an accredited college. Jeans may not sag, have holes, shreds or are torn and must be hemmed.

Walking shorts, skirt, skort, dress or jumper must be within finger tip length.

Because we are a uniform campus with a uniform dress policy, hair color is part of that expectation. No unnatural hair colors will be allowed.

DRESS CODE UPDATE

Hoodies are no longer allowed in our dress code. We are replacing them with a Garner sweatshirt sold by PTA.

COLD WEATHER DRESS POLICY

Garner sweatshirts sold by PTA may be worn at any time.

Solid color navy blue, royal blue, or white sweatshirts may also be worn at any time. (No hoodies)

Logos can be no larger than a 3x3 post-it note.

Exceptions will be made during periods of cold weather. Campus Administration will communicate cold weather days and will make any exceptions or changes if necessary.

Students will be allowed to wear cold weather jackets outdoors only before school, during passing periods or after school. Students will be expected to be in uniform during instructional times.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Sweat pants
- Hats/caps/beanies
- Oversized clothing
- Visible Undergarments
- Piercings other than ears/No Gauges
- Visible Tattoos
- Jewelry and accessories deemed offensive or dangerous
- Jeggings/tights
- Writing on clothing
- Sagging, torn, or frayed pants/shorts/jeans
- Bandanas
- Exposed midriffs or low cut tops
- Pajamas
- House shoes, slides and slippers
