

STEM Community Service Hours and PVSA Hours

STEM Hours

STEM students have a minimum number of community service hours they must acquire each year to be in compliance with our program guidelines. **STEM hours must be recorded on the STEM webpage to get credit.** You may *also* log them as NEISD and PVSA hours on the district volunteer website but you cannot use STEM hours for other club/society required hours. ***If you only log them on the district website, they will not be applied as STEM hours.*** STEM hours MUST be recorded on the STEM form! STEM service hours can be earned June 7, 2019-April 30, 2020. The **deadline for** recording them is **midnight, April 30, 2020**. You will need to have contact information for the person who supervised your volunteer work.

Presidential Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) hours may be earned from April 1st-March 31st each year. PVSA hours are not mandatory.

PVSA and other hours entered in the NEISD Volunteer database may also be applied to the NEISD Student Volunteer Service Awards.
