This year, on **Wednesday, October 23rd, 2019 @ 9:00 AM in the Library MPR**, Johnson High School is participating in the **ASVAB Career Exploration Program**, a no-cost career planning tool. You are encouraged to **visit our Career Center inside the Counseling Office to sign up and participate.**

Last year, more than 786,000 students in 13,976 high schools across the nation explored the post-secondary options and found careers with ASVAB CEP. This testing experience has been credited with inspiring young people to explore careers in the context of their skills and interests, resulting in greater career satisfaction, reduced student loan debt and less time wasted pursuing an ill-fitting field. What to expect:

1. Students don't have to do any lengthy preparation. How much you have learned through the years will probably make the most difference in your results. Those looking for practice test items can find them here: <https://www.asvabprogram.com/student-program>
 2. About two weeks after the test, results will be available and disseminated to students through the post-test interpretation session held at Johnson. At this session, you will receive access to asvabprogram.com and instructions will be provided on how to interpret your scores. You will also complete an interest inventory, conduct career exploration activities and have access to your portal for up to two years.
