ESL Class: English as a Second language classes help adults improve their English proficiency with curriculum focusing on reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills.

Families as Leaders: Families examine leadership concepts and explore their roles as leaders in their homes, communities, and schools.

Bully Prevention Tips for Parents: Participants will be provided with resources on how to assess if an incident is a “bully” incident or a peer conflict.

Math Matters: Families will discover the importance of early math development in children and how to create a numeracy-rich home environment by exploring math games and real-world math experiences.

Ready for Kindergarten: In this workshop families explore what it means to be “ready” for kindergarten.
