Typical School Day

Online Course Selection

- Parents and students will be entering their own course selections online (virtual students especially)
- Use the 6th grade course card posted on the BRadley website under “Course Selection” to guide you through required courses. There are videos and a PowerPoint. With instructions to guide you.
- Parents and students can start entering course selections on January 25th.
- Courses must be entered by Friday, February 12th.
- All choices are locked in on February 19th. At that time all changes must be made by contacting the counselor.
- Course changes are only allowed until May 28, 2021.

Steps for selecting courses in Skyward

1. Sign into Student's Skyward account
2. Click on "Course Request" icon
3. Search courses using the course # on the course card
 - Do NOT select courses that are not on the course card. Students who select inappropriate courses will be removed and added to their alternate choices.
4. Click add to select a course
 - Classes may also be removed by clicking 'remove'
5. Students will pick courses
6. Students will select 2 alternates for their electives
 - Students will place these courses under the 'alternates' tab
7. Once complete, students will submit their course requests.
