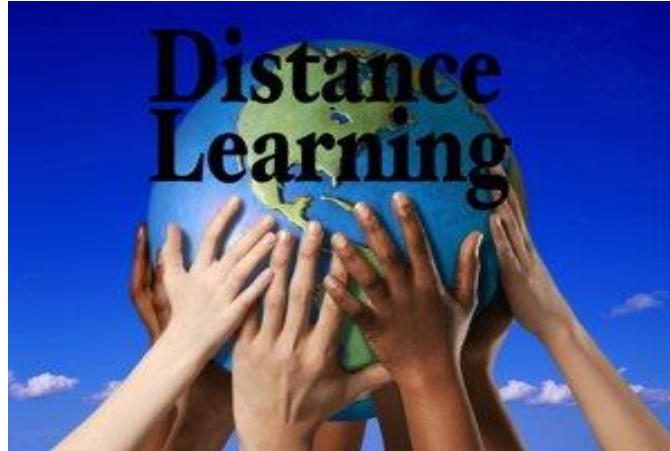


VIRTUAL CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

1. Set up your work location



- Find a quiet place free of distractions (tv, parents, toys, pets, siblings, etc.)
- Stay in one place

2. Be dressed/groomed in a manner appropriate for a classroom.



Dress Code Highlights

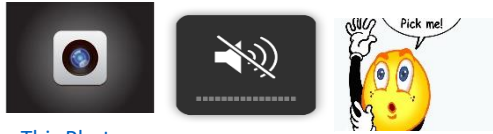
- Hair must be neat and clean. Unconventional hairstyles that are considered to be distracting and/or disruptive to the educational environment are prohibited.
- Halter tops, exposed midriffs, strapless and/or low cut tops, exposed backs, spaghetti straps, see-through clothing, and tanks with oversized armholes are not permitted. Undergarments shall not be visible or exposed.
- Clothing with inappropriate advertising or statements that are offensive or inflammatory is prohibited.
- Body piercing ornaments and other similar ornaments will be worn on the ear only.
- Visible tattoos and similar body painting(s) that promote violence, reflect gang activity, are considered offensive, inflammatory or disruptive to the learning environment are prohibited.
- Hats, caps, or other head apparel are not permitted. Hoods on hooded sweatshirts, shirts, and jackets may not be worn during instructional, passing periods, or while in the building.
- Any apparel or attire that is considered to be distracting and/or disruptive to the educational environment or is considered a safety concern is prohibited.

3. Be prepared and on time



- Have all materials ready including writing supplies, notes etc.

4. Have camera ON and microphone MUTED



- Maintain RESPECT in both speaking, writing, and appearance.
- No inappropriate language nor hand gestures.
- Stay on mute.
- Click the raise hand button if you have a question or something to share.
- Only turn on your mic if you are going to respond or ask a question until instructed by teacher.
- Never be a distraction to others.

5. Chatting



- Use chat only to post relevant comments or questions
- Messaging with other students at any time other than a time designated by the teacher for discussion is NOT acceptable.

6. Gum/Food



- Refrain from chewing gum or eating in front of the camera.
- This is considered a distraction.

7. Do NOT take pictures or videos of the meetings



8. Stay on task and focused so you don't miss anything the speaker says
