

AP Statistics Class Information 2019 - 2020

Notes: Students must keep a notebook/binder. Either print out the guided notes and annotate directly on the copies or use the PDF and annotate on ruled paper.

Assignments: Online text or handout practice will be assigned regularly.

Entrance and Exit Quizzes: Students will have these 2 - 3 days a week. They will quickly assess your vocabulary and problems from the notes. These assessments will be taken with or without notes, depending on the topics.

Review Quizzes: When Unit 1 is complete, quizzes will be done almost weekly. They will review previously learned material to practice for the AP exam.

Unit Tests: Students will complete short answer tests after each unit (9 units).

Progress Check Tests: Students will complete these online through college board. Points will vary on number of questions; 1 point per question.

AP Prep MC Tests: Students will complete these bi-weekly or monthly, based on the flow of the unit, and will be entirely multiple choice questions.

Mid-Term Exam: Students will complete this comprehensive multiple choice test on the specified day, during exam week, before winter break.

AP Mock Exam: Students will take this mock exam in April on a Saturday to be determined.

Unit Test Retakes: Students will have the opportunity to retake a unit tests, no matter what earned grade, however to qualify for this retake you must:

- Take the original test with the class.
- “Cell-i-tary Confinement” daily (AirPods and headphones included!)
- Remain on appropriate websites/content on your school issued device during class.
